Here are some great family outings that won't hurt your purse or pocket too much:

HIKE THE APPLACHACHIAN

TRAIL. The trail stretches from the Delaware Water Gap through High Point State Park and then on to Wawayanda State Park before entering New York.

HOWELL LIVINGSTON FARM. An example of what farming life was from 1890-1910, this walk back into history is fascinating.

DOYLESTOWN CASTLE. This huge wooden castle playground is eight stories high and every kids' dream.
